The Journal of Hate Studies seeks applications and nominations for two editorial positions: the Book Review Editor and the Film Review Editor. These are unpaid, professional service positions. These editors will be appointed for three-years terms to commence January 1, 2012. The appointment will be made by December 1, 2011.

The *Journal's* Book Review and Film Review Editors will select books and films, respectively, for written reviews that engage those who are part of the field of Hate Studies, as well as related areas and specialties both inside and outside of academia. The materials selected should engage academic audiences and deal with subject matter that enlivens academic inquiry. Written reviews should also highlight the significance of the material, both for academics (scholars, researchers, teachers, administrators, students) and with regard to broader concerns of hatred in society, understanding it, and addressing it.

The Book Review and Film Review Editors will maintain close communication with the Director of the Institute for Hate Studies. They are expected to work effectively as members of the *Journal's* editorial and production teams. These editors are responsible to arrange for the receipt of review copies of all appropriate books and films, find and commission reviewers, submit edited reviews to the Institute's Director, review page proofs with the editorial team, and track all books and films received. These editors may also occasionally submit their own reviews.

Letters of application or nomination should specify the particular editorial position sought. Letters should also highlight the individual's previous editorial experience (if any) and other qualification to serve in the designated editorial role. Finally, letters should highlight the individual's familiarity with Hate Studies and professional experience with the study of hatred in society, including efforts to understand and address it.

Letters must be accompanied by a complete and current CV. Letters and CVs should be submitted as PDFs and attached via email. Please send all materials to John Shuford, Director of the Institute for Hate Studies, at hatestudies@gonzaga.edu.
