Prospective students for the Doctoral Program in Leadership program are urged to apply for formal acceptance into the program as early as possible. Applications are reviewed on an on-going bases and decisions can be expected within 45 days of the submission of a completed application. Prospective students are urged to carefully choose courses in consultation with a faculty member from the department, with priority given to core course or other required courses. Unless there are special circumstances, prospective students should take not more than six credits as a non-matriculated student, and should apply for regular admission before beginning their second semester. Prospective students are cautioned that performance while enrolled as a non-matriculated student is not considered when students are considered for admission, but that students can use instructors from these courses as references.

Classes usually have an advanced assignment due the first session of the term. You should check the syllabus on the Web or contact the instructor if you have not received information about an advanced assignment.
