In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the 2010-2011 academic year. You may choose whichever plan best fits your schedule and dining habits. **Carte Blanche plans** allow students unlimited access to the Marketplace during the times listed and **Block Meal plans** provide a certain number of meals to use within a semester at the Marketplace. All meal plans, include Dining Dollars, may be used only by the cardholder.

## Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: Do I need to purchase a meal plan?**  
A: Yes! It's a great value and it is Gonzaga's policy that all designated Campus Residents purchase a meal plan each semester.
- Q. What are Dining Dollars?**  
A. Dining Dollars are cash values included in all meal plans. They work like a pre-paid debit card with funds kept on your student ID card. Dining Dollars may be used at any on-campus dining location.
- Q. Do Dining Dollars carry over from year to year?**  
A. They are carried over from the fall to the spring when a new meal plan is purchased in the spring. They are not carried over from year to year.
- Q. Do Block Meals carry over from semester to semester?**  
A. Block meals may be used during the semester in which they are purchased. They do not carry over from semester to semester.
- Q. Can I change my meal plan if it does not fit my needs?**  
A. Yes! Changing to a bigger or smaller meal plan can be done during the first week of school. Changing to a larger plan is possible at any time during the semester. All other changes must be requested by the Director of Housing at ext. 4103.
- Q. If I'm not a Resident Hall student, where do I buy my meal plan?**  
A. If you live off-campus, you can purchase Bulldog Bucks at the Campus Dining Services office located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the COG building. Cash, personal checks and credit cards are all accepted as payment.
- Q. What are Bulldog Bucks?**  
A. Bulldog Bucks are a smart and easy way to make purchases at any dining location on campus and at participating Spokane-area restaurants. The program works like a pre-paid debit card and balances carry over from year to year.
