

SYLLABUS

1. Text

The text we will be using is Spanogle, Rohner, Pridgen & Sovern, *Consumer Law* (3d ed. 2007, ISBN # 9780314161529. There is also a statutory supplement, Thomson / West, "Selected Consumer Statutes," ISBN 9780314208156. Because all the statutes are available on line you may wish to download them rather than buy the supplement (it's about \$36). But the paper supplement is convenient.

2. Course Expectations

I expect you by the end of the course to be familiar with consumer remedies, both procedural and substantive.
