

SYLLABUS

1. Text

The text we will be using is Spanogle, Rohner, Pridgen & Sovern, *Consumer Law* (3d ed. 2007, ISBN # 9780314161529). There is also a statutory supplement, Thomson / West, "Selected Consumer Statutes," ISBN 978-0314274755. Because all the statutes are available on line you may wish to download them rather than buy the supplement (it's about \$36). But the paper supplement is convenient (and there are lots of used copies available on Amazon).
